GAZETTE NOTICES ON DEREGISTERED TEACHERS

Section 30 of the Teachers Service Commission Act 2012 provides for the removal of a teacher's name from the Register of Teachers on various grounds. Further, the Act requires that the names of individuals who have been removed from the Register be published in the Kenya Gazette.

Pursuant to the Act, the names of 126 teachers who were deregistered between 26th September 2011 and 24th February 2015 were published in the Kenya Gazette Notice No.3006 of 30th April 2015. The names of another 22 teachers who were deregistered between 4th June 2015 and 7th July 2015 were published in the Kenya Gazette Notice No.2583 of 15th April 2016.

Accordingly, a person whose name has been removed from the Register of Teachers ceases to be a teacher and cannot engage in teaching activities in any learning institution, whether public or private.

By a copy of this circular, Boards of Management, Principals, Headteachers of public learning institutions, Directors and proprietors of private schools are advised as follows:

- i. The two Kenya Gazette Notices with the names of teachers who have been deregistered have been sent to all TSC County and Sub County offices and posted on the TSC website www.tsc.go.ke for the information of all stakeholders.

- ii. The deregistered individuals are no longer teachers and should not, therefore, be employed or engaged to teach in any learning institution, whether private or public.
- iii. Before any recruitment of teachers at the institutional level, Boards of Management should verify with the Teachers Service Commission the registration status of individuals who may have previously been employed by TSC.
- iv. Compliance with the provisions on teacher registration and deregistration will form part of routine monitoring programmes by TSC officers.

Finally, TSC County and Sub County Directors should ensure the contents of this circular are brought to the attention of Principals, Headteachers, and Directors and / or Proprietors of Private schools.
